



SHOWER ENCLOSURES

Shower Enclosures have the largest footprint in the bathroom. Customers need to define their minimum requirements regarding shower space at the outset and all other bathroom products should be chosen with this in mind.

Things to consider when selecting a shower enclosure:


- Tray Type acrylic, resin stone, metal
- Use Aquastrap to tie the tray to the wall
- Use concrete boards rather than plaster board in the showering area
- Ensure that all screws on the concrete board are sealed
- Use tanking membrane that is suitable for tiles and adhesive
- Tank to 300mm outside the shower area
- Check height restrictions on shower door
- For shower doors that open out, ensure they will not come into contact with other products
- Shower doors are not waterproof





Shower Doors

Shower doors are manufactured with a toughened safety glass which is available in 6mm, 8mm and 10mm. Many manufacturers now apply a "stay clean" product to the inside of the door. The majority of doors available from TileStyle have lifetime warranties. We also supply replacement seals.









Pivot Doors

With Pivot Doors, the door opens outwards, with part of it opening into the showering area. It can be installed with an inline or return panel.




Infold Doors

The Infold Door opens into the enclosure allowing it to fit comfortably into smaller bathrooms.









Slider Doors


The Slider Door rests on quick release double rollers facilitating easy cleaning.





Quadrant Doors

The Quadrant Door creates a curved enclosure up to 1000mm.



Offset Quadrant Doors

The Offset Quadrant Door offers curved lines from 900x760 up to 1400x800mm.






Corner Entry Doors

The Corner Entry Door is a perfect solution for small bathrooms or awkward spaces as the doors slide back within the confines of the shower itself.



Bespoke Doors

Shower Trays

Shower Trays generally go up in 100mm sizes starting from 700mm. Shapes incorporate square, rectangular, quadrant and offset quadrant.

Acrylic Trays

Acrylic Trays are angled and contoured to match enclosures and spaces. They are available in low level or with tray panel kits for easy installation.




Resin Stone Trays

Resin Stone Trays can be cut to accommodate the specific space. They are available in a large number of sizes and finishes. The greatest challenge is ensuring that they are level during installation as there is a fall within the tray.
